I. THE UNUSUAL TRIAL OF JESUS (Mark 15:1-5)

In between Mark 15:5 and Mark 15:6...

– Since Jesus is from Galilee, Pilate sends Jesus to Herod.

– Herod is disappointed because Jesus won't perform miracles for him.

– Herod sends Jesus back to Pilate.

Luke 23:13-16

13 “Pilate summoned the chief priests and the rulers and the people, 14 and said to them, “You brought this man to me as one who incites the people to rebellion, and behold, having examined Him before you, I have found no guilt in this man regarding the charges which you make against Him. 15 No, nor has Herod, for he sent Him back to us; and behold, nothing deserving death has been done by Him. 16 Therefore I will punish Him and release Him.”

10 So Pilate *said to Him, “You do not speak to me? Do You not know that I have authority to release You, and I have authority to crucify You?”

11 Jesus answered, “You would have no authority over Me, unless it had been given you from above; for this reason he who delivered Me to you has the greater sin.”

12 As a result of this Pilate made efforts to release Him, but the Jews cried out saying, “If you release this Man, you are no friend of Caesar; everyone who makes himself out to be a king opposes Caesar.”
